

Condiment Slinger

It's my intention that this idea should be a part of the public domain and should never be patented.

This idea was posted on the internet, and was declared to be public domain, prior to Monday, October 30, 2006.

This document was most recently revised on Saturday, June 8, 2013.

This document is approximately 285 words long.

This idea was suggested by a man in whose house I lived for a while. I built the thing for him. The device shown in the pictures is the prototype. I never built another one after the prototype. To me, it didn't seem like a useful device.

The condiment slinger shown in the pictures works with Kraft brand horseradish sauce. You'll need a different condiment slinger for each different variety of condiment unless, of course, you figure out how to build a universal one.

The condiment slinger shown in the pictures was made from an empty horseradish sauce bottle. I cut away part of the top and part of the bottom, leaving enough that I could slip another, new bottle into it. I slit the sides a little, for an easier fit. I punched two holes in it and attached a string. The man for whom I built the thing would spin it around and around to drive the remaining condiment to the top of a nearly empty bottle, so that he could use the entire quantity of the condiment.

Be careful. He slung it once with a damaged lid and had quite a mess to clean up. Naturally, he thought that I should clean up the mess. I recommend that, if you build one of these things, you use it outside.
