TO PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

This report is intended to be a summary of all that pertains to the pupil's work during the year. Care should be taken, therefore, not to soil or lose this card. No pupil will be eligible for promotion whose Scholarship, as indicated by this report, is below 80 per cent., and whose Term Standing in any branch is lower than 70 per cent, and no pupil will be promoted whose conduct shall not be such that would recommend him to the esteem of his teachers and fellow pupils. Should anything of an unsatisfactory character be discovered by means of this report or otherwise, it is earnestly desired that you call on the Teacher, the Principal or the Superintendent at the earliest convenience. By so doing, misunderstandings may be avoided, and those most interested in the welfare of the pupils will mutually assist each other. The schools cannot do good work without the co-operation of the home, and in order that the school may serve the children in the fullest measure, it is hoped that parents and guardians will help in all possible ways, in securing the interest, regular attendance, excellent deportment and proper effort of the pupils.

Pupils who are tardy or absent from school shall, on their return, bring written excuses stating reasons for absence, from parent or guardian. Sickness of pupils, indisposition of some member of the family, or some pressing emergency shall be considered the only legitimate excuse for absence. All absence and tardiness not excused in accordance with this regulation shall be denominated as "Unexcused" absence or tardiness and shall be so entered upon the records of the school.

No pupil shall be excused from any subject in the required course except on account of physical infirmity, or mental debility, certified to by a reputable physician, and then only at the direction of the Superintendent. Pupils absent from examination or recitations shall, in determining scholarship standings, be regarded as having failed on such examination or recitation; in the discretion of the teachers and principals, however, pupils whose absence is excused for reasons mentioned above, may make up delinquent work before the close of the term.
